### Palm Powered Smart Device

#### Quick Start Guide

If the client is not pre-loaded on your device, download it from your PCS Business Connection web account. If you can't find it, contact your carrier and ask for the PCS Business Connection Palm OS Client.

These instructions assume that you have completed the following tasks:

- Installed the Palm Desktop software
- HotSynced your device with your desktop computer
- Browsed the Internet on your device

See your Palm OS documentation for more information.

#### Installing the Client

1. On your desktop computer, open a web browser and log in to your PCS Business Connection account.  
See your welcome material for information about how to log in.
2. On the Downloads page, enter the mobile number and brand for the device on which you will install the client.
3. When the list of devices appears, select your device and click **Next**.
4. Follow the instructions to download and install the client.
  - a. Click **Download**.
  - b. Save the installer file on your desktop computer.
  - c. Connect the device to the cradle or cable.
  - d. Double-click the installer file to start the installer wizard.
  - e. Follow the instructions in the wizard.
5. Register the client.

#### Registering Client

1. On the Main page, tap the Biz Conn icon to open the client.
2. Follow the prompts to enter your account information to initialize the client.

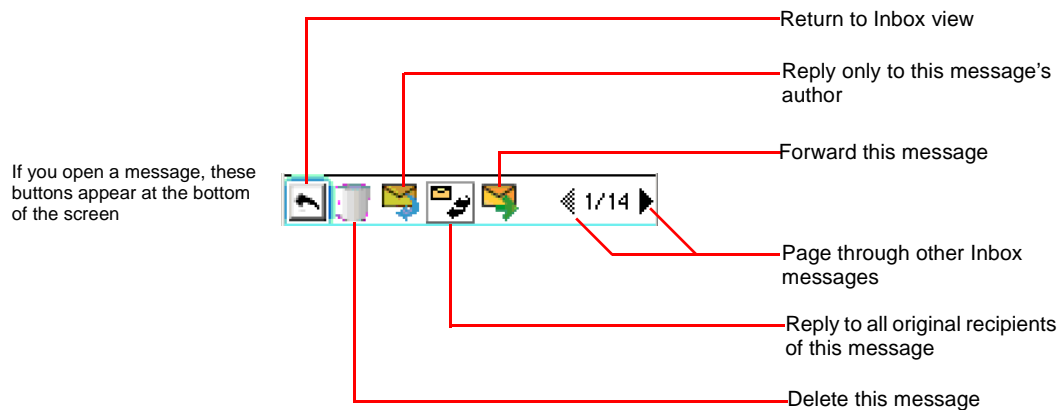
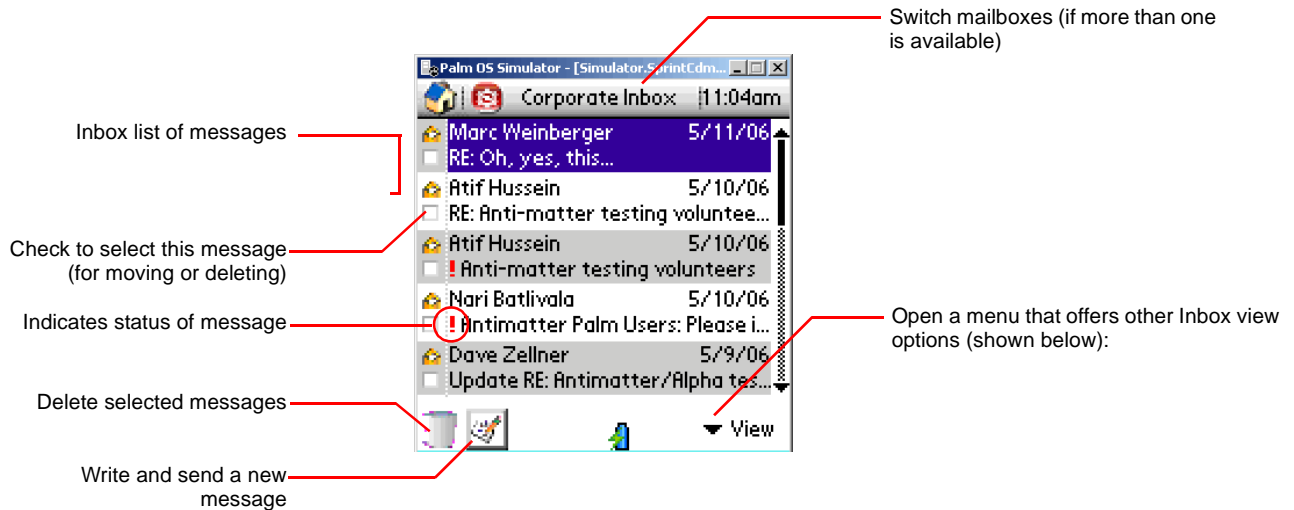
This information must match the information you use to sign in to your PCS Business Connection account. Some information might be prefilled. Find your Enterprise ID (if any), User name, Password, and Registration code (if any) in your welcome email message.
3. After you finish entering your information tap **Register** to generate security keys.

4. When a connection is established, the home screen appears.



## Inbox View

Use the Inbox to send, receive, and manage email on this phone.



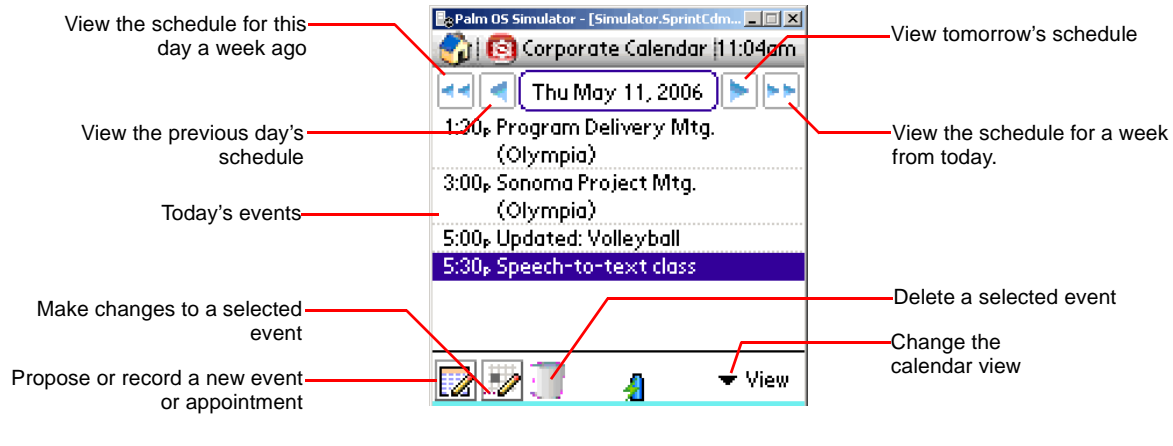
### About the Inbox view

If you turn off Push, you will not receive any updates from the server. Press and hold either the Mail or the Calendar button to receive messages at any time.

Your mail stays in the Inbox unless you delete it, which removes the copy on your phone. To permanently delete a message or to save it in another folder, use the email program on your PC.

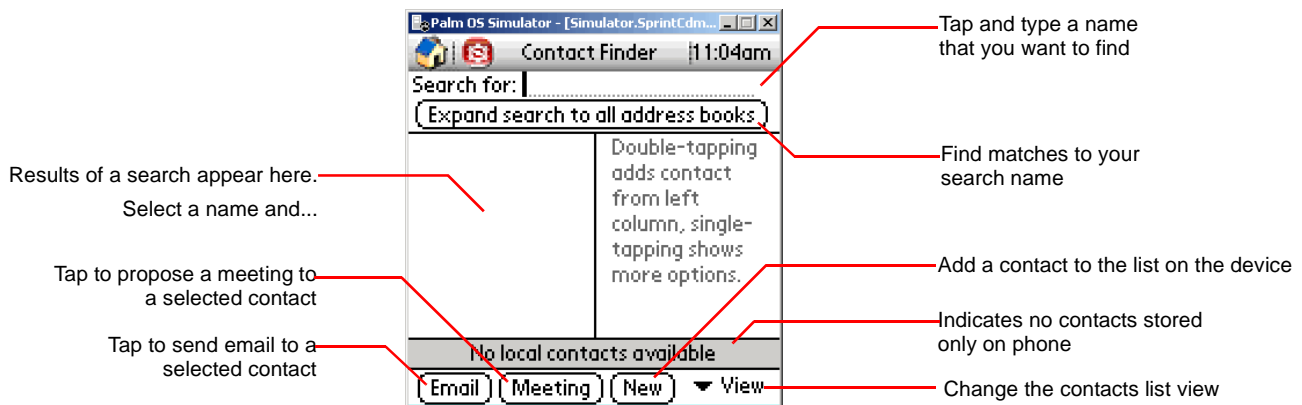
## Calendar view

The Calendar view keeps you updated on your personal or corporate calendar and lets you propose and manage your appointments and meetings.



## Contact Finder View

Use the Contact Finder view to access a copy of the contacts list downloaded from the currently active email service account. (This requires that a directory of contacts exists on your email service provider's server.)



### About the Contact Finder View

You can search your corporate contacts directory from this phone. If your carrier or ISP has access to your personal contacts through the email service provider, you have access to those contacts with this phone.

If you use a POPmail service, you will have to create new mail contacts on the phone because your existing address book is not available.

## Updating the Client Software

To check for updates to the Palm OS client:

1. On the Main page, tap the PCS Business Connection icon to display the Home screen.
2. Use the 5-way to press Up twice.
3. Tap **Check for Updates**  
The dialog will say whether an update is available.
4. Follow the prompts to update now or to receive a reminder in three days.

### **To respond to a Version-Update Notification**

1. When the notification appears, make one of the following choices:
  - Select **Update** to download the latest version.
  - Select **Remind Me Later** to receive a reminder in three days.
